


Michelson Diagnostics Ltd – Environmental Policy – updated Jan 08

At Michelson Diagnostics Ltd (MDL), we passionately believe in the importance of protecting our Earth and its population from the adverse effects of generating pollution and waste. Therefore, we act to eliminate or minimise MDL's carbon footprint and other pollutants, via company-wide adoption of effective, 'green', working practices and policies. Our goal is to be a zero-emissions company, with a reputation in our market sector of 'best-in-class' environmental performance.

MDL is a medical imaging engineering company, which manufactures products for the global scientific and medical sectors. We impact the environment through manufacturing, customer use of our products, disposal at the end of their lifecycle, and through the use of resources by our staff in day-to-day business. We try to continuously reduce our impact in all of these areas, but below is a brief summary of the impact in each area, and the environmental measures that we have adopted to combat them:

Impact	MDL Environmental Measures adopted
Some waste product chemicals are generated in manufacturing process (glues, fluxes, washes etc.) Packaging for product delivery	Comply with relevant environmental legislation on chemical disposal Policy to use subcontractors with same commitment Re-usable packaging
Use of electricity and other resources to operate product	Products designed for efficient energy use Products designed to enable rapid shut down and re-start, to encourage user to turn off when not in use. No material consumables required to operate products
Disposal of products at end of life	Key components can be refurbished (laser) Most components can be replaced, extending the product lifetime Customers may return products to MDL for disposal Products are not made from chemicals that are not readily disposable
Travel by staff	Carbon offset of all business travel (including car, rail and air travel) Use VoIP teleconference rather than travel to meetings, where possible Staff encouraged to work from home when appropriate
Packaging from deliveries to MDL	Re-use packaging where possible Re-cycle all packaging
Office resources used	Re-cycle laser and inkjet cartridges Re-use printer paper, then re-cycle Turn off computers and lights when not in use

At MDL, we are always looking for ways to reduce our environmental impact, and all staff are trained in environmental practices, to put forward ideas for improvement and to 'think green'. We expect subcontractors to do likewise, and adoption of 'green' policies is a key criterion for choosing our suppliers. Our environmental policy is reviewed and updated annually by the Chief Executive, management team and Board of Directors.
